

Black Creek Village Library Display and Exhibits Policy

The Black Creek Village Library welcomes the opportunity to allow community groups and individuals to use the various display and exhibit areas in the building. Hallway bulletin board space is provided for postings of an educational, cultural, intellectual, charitable or recreational nature provided there is room for such displays and they are of reasonable size. Display areas may also be used for materials from the Library's collection, or to publicize library services, collections, or activities.

No poster, display, exhibit, pamphlet, brochure, leaflet, or booklet shall be exhibited, displayed or placed in the library for distribution without permission from the Library director.

No outside organization or individual shall be permitted to display or exhibit any materials, leaflets, or posters which advocate the election or defeat of a candidate for public office, or which advocate an affirmative or negative vote for or against any proposition, whether political or otherwise.

No organization or individual shall be permitted to place in the library any box, receptacle or canister which solicits donations, without prior approval of the Library director.

The Library does not endorse content nor imply agreement or disagreement with beliefs or viewpoints expressed in the exhibits or display areas.

Library staff shall remove bulletin board postings and events notices as appropriate and discard notices unless otherwise notified.
