

BLACK CREEK VILLAGE LIBRARY WIRELESS USE POLICY

The library provides free public Internet access through a Wi-Fi network. Patrons and visitors who access this network are expected to do so in a legal and appropriate way.

- Users are not to engage in any illegal activity (e.g. hacking, pirating, downloading of illegal materials, etc.)
- Printing is not available on the wireless network at this time, but users may save their work to a USB drive and print from one of the library's public computers or directly from the public printer.
- Mobile devices and electronics may be plugged into existing electrical outlets provided that power cords do not extend into aisles or otherwise prevent a safety hazard.
- Users of mobile devices and electronics are expected to be considerate of other patrons and are required to wear headphones when using sound.
- Although staff will make all attempts to meet a user's needs, limited technical support is available through onsite personnel. The library cannot guarantee that that all hardware will work with our wi-fi network.
- The library reserves the right to end wireless sessions of anyone in violation of this policy.
- The user accepts all risks in connecting to the wireless network. Anti-virus and security protection are the responsibility of the user.
- Wireless users should never leave laptops or devices unattended in the library, even briefly.
