BLACK CREEK VILLAGE LIBRARY EMERGENCY CLOSURE POLICY

The Black Creek Village Library will make every reasonable effort to open to the public as scheduled, while also considering the safety of the public and staff. At times when the weather becomes hazardous to the health and/or safety of the public and/or library staff, the library will close, delay opening or close ahead of schedule. If the Library is closed for any circumstances related to weather, including flooding or power outages, all employees will receive compensation for the time they would normally have been scheduled to work.

The decision to close or postpone the opening of the library-due to inclement weather or weather-related issues such as flooding or power outage-will be reached after consultation with Library Board President and/or Village Clerk and is at the discretion of the Library Director.

If the Seymour Community School District chooses not to open for the day due to inclement weather, the Black Creek Village Library will be closed as well.

If the building is to close early, library patrons already in the facility will be notified immediately.

National or State weather service advisories concerning travel during storm conditions, or during the clean-up afterwards, will always be followed.
