

BLACK CREEK VILLAGE LIBRARY ACCESS POLICY

The Black Creek Village Library will serve all residents of the community and the public library system area.

Service will not be denied or reduced because of religious, racial, social, economic, or political status.

Service will not be denied or reduced because of mental, emotional, or physical condition, age or sexual orientation.

Everyone has the right to use library resources provided his or her behavior does not unreasonably interfere with the rights of others to do the same. An individual has the right to use the library without being unreasonably disturbed by others.

The use of the library or library materials may be denied for due cause. Such cause may be failure to return library materials per library card holder agreement, destruction of library property, disturbance of other patrons or any other disruptive or objectionable conduct on library premises at the discretion of library staff.
