

BLACK CREEK VILLAGE LIBRARY POLICY ON POLICIES

Per Wisconsin Statutes Chapter 43.58, the Library Board is the policy-setting body for the Black Creek Village Library.

The Library is subject to all applicable federal and state laws and regulations, as well as Village ordinances, and such Village policies as may be approved by the Library Board.

The Library Director is responsible for bringing policies to the Library Board: In the case of policies specific to library services, the Director will draft policies with appropriate input from staff, Board and Village departments.

The Director will place any policy changes on the Library Board's meeting agenda. Any new policy will be presented as an action item.

Any policy changes which the Library Director deems substantive in affecting Library services, facilities, finances or staff will be presented as an action item, subject to approval by a majority vote of the Board.

Policies will be reviewed for practicality and efficacy every three years at minimum.
